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Understanding Our Work

Our work with School Management Committees

Samarthya is an initiative of Association For Equitable Educational Spaces. Samarthya has been working with SMCs in North East Delhi since May 2016. Our intervention is aimed at increasing community participation in government schools by activating SMCs. We do this by conducting capacity building sessions and and by providing support to SMCs for grievance redressal with SMCs.

Impact Evaluation Process

Understanding SMC Baseline

New SMCs were constituted in Delhi during the month of November, 2017. To assess the quality of intervention and the progress made by SMCs, Samarthya conducted its Midline from March 19-April 19. The data was collected from SMC members individually via personal interviews.

This presentation summarises the data collected from all the SMC members.




Key Findings

Frequency of SMC meetings




More than 51% of the parents reported that SMC meetings happen regularly (at least once month)

Presence (or attendance in SMC Meetings)




More than 92% of the parents reported that least 50% parent members are usually present for SMC meetings

Meeting Agenda




More than 69% of the parents reported that agenda is regularly co-created by parents and School staff and parents actively contribute to this agenda

Decision in SMC meetings



63% of the parent SMC members reported that decision in SMCs meetings are taken in consensus with all members

Decision in SMC meetings




72% of the parent SMC members have started started issues, documenting and following up on the same

School Visits (per month)

In Baseline, 96% parent members visited school irregularly

In Midline, 41% parent members reported to visiting school regularly and performing duties



Awareness about SMC roles and responsibilities

In Baseline, 42% parent members were unaware of their roles and responsibilities

In Midline, 58% members recalled their roles and responsibilities along with performing some of these on a regular basis

No SMC is at Dysfunctional level


All SMCs have moved across the SMC rubric *

Overall, the Baseline scores of SMCs ranged between 15-22

In Midline, the overall scores of SMCs have gone up.
Range of scores lie between 27-32


Challenges

Information to community/parents



27% percent of the SMC members report that PTMs are organized regularly wherein SMCs interact with community and gives updates about school
